

Midwest Chapter of MLA Invites Applications for the Phyllis J. Schoonover Scholarship for Student Members

**82nd Annual Meeting
October 27-29, 2022
Bloomington, Indiana**



I. The scholarship supports portions of the expenses related to attending this year's annual chapter meeting October 27-29, 2022 Bloomington, Indiana. The application deadline is September 22, 2022.

The Scholarship may be awarded for up to \$500, and may be used to offset the following conference expenses:

1. Lodging for the two nights of the conference (Thursday and Friday) at one-half of the double occupancy rate;
2. Expenses for meals, reimbursed at the CONUS rate for one full day (Friday) and two partial days (Thursday and Saturday);
3. Travel by car/plane/train/bus, generally by the least expensive method. (If mileage for a personal vehicle is awarded, it will be paid at the current IRS rate at the time of the conference.)
4. Other expenses related to attending the conference.

Award recipients who are not already members of the Midwest Chapter of MLA are expected to join prior to attending the October meeting. Award recipients are also expected to contribute a summary of one session of the Chapter meeting to be published in the Midwest NoteBook.

Supporting our colleagues' involvement in the life of the chapter is a priority! **Students currently enrolled in library school are eligible** for this opportunity and are encouraged to apply. Applicants must attend a library school program in one of the states comprising the Midwest Chapter (Illinois, Indiana, Iowa, Kentucky, Michigan, Minnesota, Missouri, Ohio, and Wisconsin), and must also aspire to become a music librarian. Priority will be given to second-year student applicants. Previous recipients may reapply for the scholarship, but priority would be given to first-time recipients.

II. Applicants must submit the following to arrive by September 22, 2022. Applicants will be evaluated on the quality of the application.

1. A cover sheet with the following information: date of application; name of applicant/nominee; email address of applicant/nominee; name of nominating chapter member (if applicable); and name of library school.
2. A cover letter describing the applicant's interests in music librarianship and why attending the meeting would be meaningful (up to 200 words). Applicants should include a brief statement of professional goals as they related to conference attendance.
